

Recent accounts of DHL Express' (DHL) proposed transaction with United Parcel Service (UPS) have come to our attention. We have some concerns over how this contractual arrangement will be structured, and the competitive impact that may accompany the consummation of such a transaction. Accordingly, please be advised that all documents and other materials pertaining to the planning, analysis and/or negotiation of the above-referenced proposed transaction may be relevant to any investigation or review of the deal that the Office of the Ohio Attorney General may undertake. As such, this letter constitutes notice that any and all such documents and other materials should be preserved and any scheduled destruction of records pursuant to existing records retention schedules should be suspended pending notice to the contrary from this Office.
